**SCHEDULED WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION...  
...ST. ANDREW AREAS TO BE AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works will continue in the **Stony Hill area of St. Andrew** for the week **March 25 to April 1, 2011**. Consequently, **customers and commuters in the area will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road closure/restrictions for the period. Areas that will be affected include:**

**Old Stony Hill Road on Tuesday, March 29**

**Old Stony Hill Road at the junction of Stillwell Road on Wednesday, March 30**

**Montgomery Terrace on Thursday, March 31 to Friday, April 1**

**Stony Hill main road on Friday, April 1**

**Where lane restrictions/closures are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should also be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily, except in the case of Montgomery where the disruption will last for two days from Thursday March 31 until Friday, April 1, 2011.**

**Excavation and asphalt works will also be carried out on Old Stony Hill road starting from Monday, March 28 through to April 16, 2011.**

Customers in the mentioned areas are urged to store water for the periods of service disruption and commuters are encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of the flag personnel on location.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
