**SCHEDULED WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION
...Sections of St. Andrew & St. Catherine to be affected**

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **sections of St. Andrew** who are served by the **Chancery Hall Well and Havendale Pumping Station** that they will experience disruptions in their water supply on **Wednesday, March 30, and again on Thursday, March 31, 2011 between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00pm** on both days as the company will be carrying out maintenance works on these systems.

Areas that will be affected by these interruptions in service include: **Meadowbrook, sections of Red Hills Road, sections of Chancery Hall Heights including Cadiz Close, Lady Hamilton Drive, Van Guard, Wayne Close, Lord Nelson, Horatio Drive, To-Gallant Road, sections of East Kirkland Heights and sections of Michigan Avenue.**

In the meantime, **the Browns Well located in St. Catherine** will be taken out of operation for extensive maintenance works on **Wednesday, March 30 at 10:00am**. This will result in water supply disruption to a number of areas including; **Ebony Vale, Friendship Housing Scheme, Fairview Park, Paul Mountain, Frazers Content, Dark Hole, Banana Hole and sections of Kitson Town.**

This service interruption will last **until Friday, April 1, 2011**. Trucked water will therefore be provided to the affected areas until restoration of the system.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these service interruptions and urges its valued customers in all the mentioned areas to store water for the periods specified.
