### **Project Works Continue to Affect Traffic & Water Supply in Stony Hill Areas**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works will continue in the Stony Hill area of St. Andrew for the week April 4-8, 2011. Consequently, **customers and commuters in the area will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road closure/restrictions for the period. Areas that will be affected include:**

**Hermitage Road – Tuesday, April 4, 2011.**

**Fort Georges Crescent – Wednesday, April 6, 2011.**

**Old Stony Hill Road – Thursday April 7, to Friday April 8, 2011**

**Allside Way – Friday, April 8, 2011.**

**Where lane restrictions are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily, except for Old Stony Hill Road where the disruption will last for two days.**

**In addition, excavation works will be on Montgomery Drive for the period April 4 to April 23, 2011. Asphalt works will also be carried out on Hermitage Road, Stillwell Road, Mannings Hill Road, Castle Drive, Fort Georges Crescent, Orange View Drive, Montgomery Drive, Brooks Level Road, Old Stony Hill Road, Stillwell Road and Stony Hill Road during the period.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by this necessary improvement works and urges customers to store water for the periods of service disruption. Commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and flagmen that will be in place.
