MECHANICAL PROBLEMS CAUSE WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION

...Sections of St. Andrew & Clarendon Affected

The National Water Commission is reporting that the **Chancery Hall # 2 Pumping Station in St. Andrew** is currently out of operation due to mechanical problems being experienced with the system. This has resulted in no water conditions and low water pressure to customers in the following areas:

Sections of East Kirkland Heights, Flagstaff, To-Gallant Way, Horatio Drive, Lord Nelson Drive and Lady Hamilton Drive. Trucked water is being provided to these areas until the necessary repair works are complete.

In the meantime, customers in sections of **Clarendon** who are served by the **Mineral Heights Well** may experience similar low water pressure and no water conditions, also due to mechanical problems associated with the Well. Areas affected by this disruption in service include: **Mineral Heights, Halse Hall, May Pen, Curatoe Hill, Canaan Heights, Trenton Road, Longbridge Avenue and Sunnyside Avenue.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its customers in these all these areas and is striving to ensure restoration of normal water supply at the earliest possible time.
