PROJECT WORKS TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN ST. ANDREW AREAS

The National Water Commission is reporting that customers in some sections of St. Andrew will experience disruptions in their water supply for the period **Monday, April 18 through to Thursday, April 21, 2011**. This disruption is to facilitate works that will be carried out on some of the company's facilities as follows:

Havendale Well and Hope High Level on Monday, April 18, which will impact water supply to **Havendale, Meadowbrook, Chancery Hall Heights, Smokey Vale, Papine, Kintyre, Hope Flats and Gordon Town and surrounding areas.**

Long Mountain system on Tuesday, April 19, which will affect water supply to **Harbour View, Palisadoes, Port Royal and Seven Miles**

Mona Treatment Plant on Wednesday, April 20 which will impact water supply to **Mona, sections of Cross Roads, Mountain View, Old Hope Road, Devon Square, sections of Half-Way-Tree Road, Upper Maxfield Avenue, Dunrobin Avenue, New Kingston, Mona Road, Ravina, Hagley Park Road, Harbour View, Shooters Hill and Bull Bay.**

And **Constant Spring Treatment Plant on Thursday, April 21**. This will affect water supply to **Constant Spring Road, Constant Spring Gardens, Half-Way-Tree Road, sections of Cross Roads, Mannings Hill Road, Cassia Park Road, Washington Boulevard and roads leading off, Dunrobin Avenue, Calabar Mews and surrounding areas.**

Customers who are served by these facilities will experience low water pressure or no water conditions between the hours of 10:00am and 4:00pm on the days that the works will be carried out on the systems except in the case of Hope High Level where work will be done on Monday, April 18 at 8:00pm to Tuesday, April 19 at 2:00am.

Similarly, customers in the Stony Hill area will experience water supply and traffic disruptions as the network improvement works continue under the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP). Areas that will be affected include:

Old Stony Hill Road and Reidgfield Avenue on Tuesday, April 19, Stilwell Road on Wednesday, April 20, Old Stony Hill Road and Stilwell Road on Thursday, April 21.

Where lane restrictions are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily, except on Stilwell Road where the disruption will last for two days, from **Wednesday, April 20 to Thursday, April 21, 2011.**

Preparation and asphalt works will be conducted on **Montgomery Drive, Montgomery Terrace, Old Stony Hill Road, Main Stony Hill Road, Brooks Level Road, Richens Close, Stilwell Road and Fort Georges Height** for the period. Excavation works will also be carried out on **Old Stony Hill Road from Monday, April 18 through to Saturday, May 7, 2011.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works and urges customers to store water for the periods of disruption. Where there are lane restrictions, commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of flag personnel who are in place.
