**Mechanical & Electrical Problems Cause Water Supply Disruption  
...Sections of St. Thomas Affected**

The National Water Commission is advising its customers in sections of **St. Thomas** who are served by the **Prospect Deep Well** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to mechanical problems at the facility. The Well has therefore been taken out of operation to carry out the necessary repair work.

Areas affected by this disruption in service include:

**Lyssons**  
**Prospect**  
**Leith Hall**  
**Blue Mahoe**  
**Retreat**  
**Industry Hill**  
**Beckford Town**  
**Johns Town**

Similarly, customers in **Western Yallahs, South Haven, Llundville and Baptist** who are served by the **South Haven Well, also located in St. Thomas**, are being advised that the low water pressure and no water conditions that they are currently experiencing is due to electrical problems at the facility. The necessary repair work is being carried out and normal water supply will be restored at the earliest possible time.
