PROJECT WORKS UPDATE...Change in Schedule
...Water Supply Disruption in Sections of St. Mary

The National Water Commission is advising that further to a news release issued on Friday, April 15, 2011, regarding project works to be done during the course of this week on the Mona Treatment Plant and the Constant Spring system, there has been a change in the previously announced schedule.

Whereas works were previously scheduled for the Mona Treatment Plant on Wednesday, April 20, 2011 between the hours of 10:00am and 4:00pm, and for Constant Spring on Thursday, April 21 at 10:00am and 4:00pm; **works will now be done on Constant Spring on Wednesday, April 20 between the hours of 7:00am and 6:00pm and at Mona on Thursday, April, 21 at 10:00am to 4:00pm.**

This change in schedule is to facilitate the interconnection of pipelines due to the work being carried out by the National Works Agency along the Washington Boulevard. In addition to these changes, the **Ferry Hill System will also be locked on Wednesday, April 20 at 7:00am to 6:00pm** also to accommodate the interconnection works.

Customers in the Corporate Area who are served by these facilities will therefore experience low water pressure or no water conditions for the periods indicated and are therefore being urged to store water for use until restoration of normal water supply.

In the meantime, National Water Commission customers in sections of **St. Mary who are served by the Trinity Relift Station** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to extensive mechanical problems at the facility. The system has been taken out of operation to carry out the necessary repairs and the Commission will provide trucked water to the affected areas until the restoration of the system.

Areas affected by this disruption include: **Albion Mountain, Trinity Land, Cambridge, Grey Street, Sand Side, Went Worth.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers and will provide further updates in these regards.
