The National Water Commission wishes to remind the public that the no water conditions now being experienced in sections of the Corporate Area is the result of a scheduled major operation on the Constant Spring and Ferry Water Supply System which was previously announced in the media.

It is expected that normal piped water supply will be restored by 6:00 p.m.

**Constant Spring, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Half-Way-Tree, Manor Park, Shortwood, Graham Heights, Eastwood Park Gardens, Hughenden, along Barbican Road, Constant Spring Road, Mannings Hill Road, Red Hills Road, Spanish Town Road, Washington Boulevard, Smokey Vale, Lower Jacks Hill Road, Zaidie Gardens, State Gardens, Duhaney Park, and sections of Down Town Kingston.**
