**SCHEDULED WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION...
...ST. ANDREW AREAS TO BE AFFECTED**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works will continue in the **Stony Hill area of St. Andrew** for the week **May 2 to May 6, 2011**. Consequently, **customers and commuters in the area will experience both water supply interruptions as well as road closure/restrictions for the period. Areas that will be affected include:**

Old Stony Hill Road on Tuesday, May 3, 2011

Seaview Road on Wednesday, May 4, 2011

Hermitage Road and Jacks Hill areas on Thursday, May 5, to Friday, May 6, 2011

Stilwell Road Road on Friday, May 6, 2011

Where lane restrictions/closures are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should also be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily, except in the case of Jacks Hill areas where the disruption will last for two days from Thursday May 5, until Friday, May 6, 2011.

Excavation works will be undertaken at Red Gate starting on Monday, May 2 until Saturday, May 21. Preparation and asphalt works will also be carried out on Old Stony Hill Road, Stilwell Road, Montgomery Drive, Orange View Drive and Seaview Road for the period.

Customers in the mentioned areas are urged to store water for the periods of service disruption and commuters are encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of the flag personnel on location.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
