**CLOSURE OF SEAVIEW FILTER PLANT TO IMPACT WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW**

As works continue under the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)**, the National Water Commission is reporting that a **section of the Seaview Filter Plant which is located in St. Andrew will be closed for extensive upgrading works for the month of May.**

This closure will result in reduced output from the plant and will cause instances of low water pressure and possible no water conditions to some customers in the following areas: **Stony Hill, Temple Hall, Golden Spring, Jack's Hill, Stilwell Road, Lawrence Tavern, Tavistock, Mannings Hill, Bridge Mount, Sunset Avenue, Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle.**

Customers in these areas are therefore being urged to store water for the periods of disruption. Trucked water will also be provided where necessary to minimize the extent of the disruption to elevated areas.
