## **LEAK REPAIRS DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY**

National Water Commission customers in **St. Thomas** who are served by the **Apple Farm** water supply system are being advised that major leak repair works are currently in progress on this system resulting in low water pressure or no water conditions to the following areas:

**Springfield, Barking Lodge, New Pera, Hill Top, Chapel Hill, Cracket Hill, Ginger Piece, Pear Tree River, Batchelor's Hall, Apple Farm and environs, Dalvey, Duckenfield, Hampton Court, Cheswick, Brownman Hill, Braeton Hill, Hill Sixty, Rocky Point, Winchester, Stokes Hall, Golden Grove and Bowden.**

Additionally, customers in sections of the **corporate area** who are served by the **Mona Treatment Plant** are currently experiencing a similar disruption due to works being carried out on a 21" main in the vicinity of Swallowfield.

Areas impacted include sections of **Cross Roads, Trench Town and sections of Down Town Kingston.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary repair works and will ensure the restoration of normal water supply at the earliest possible time.
