The National Water Commission wishes to advise some customers in sections of the Corporate Area who are served by the **Mona Treatment Plant** that the low water pressure or no water conditions they are currently experiencing is due to emergency pipeline repairs being carried out on a 21” distribution main.

Areas affected by this disruption include:

Stanton Terrace, Herb Mckinley Drive, Roosevelt Avenue, South Camp Road, Trench Town, Denham Town, Campbell Town and sections of Harbour View and Downtown Kingston.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused and assures its valuable customers that every effort is being made to restore supply in the shortest possible time.
