**LEAK REPAIR WORKS TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY
...SECTIONS OF CORPORATE AREA & CLARENDON TO BE AFFECTED**

The National Water is reporting that it will be carrying out an underground leak repair on a section of the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant system tonight, between the hours of 8:00pm and 4:00am**. Customers in sections of the corporate area will therefore experience low water pressure or no water conditions during the period.

Areas that will be affected include:

Constant Spring Road, Constant Spring Gardens, Dunrobin Avenue and all roads leading off, the upper section of Washington Boulevard and all roads leading off, Half Way Tree Road, sections of Cross Roads, Calabar Mews, Red Hills Road and surrounding areas.

Similarly, customers in **sections of Clarendon** who are served by the **Low Ground water supply system will experience a disruption in their water supply on Friday, May 6, 2011 between 8:30am and 5:00pm** due to the temporary shutdown of the system to facilitate leak repairs on a 10" transmission main.

Areas that will be impacted by this interruption in service include: **Woodhall, Chapleton, New Longville and surrounding areas.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience these necessary works may cause and urges customers to store water for the period of disruption. Every effort will be made to restore normal water supply to all the affected areas in the time specified.
