WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTING
SECTIONS OF TRELAWNY & ST. JAMES

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise customers served by the Queen of Spain # 3 Well in Trelawny that the interruption they are experiencing is due to an electrical problem at the latter facility. This situation has been aggravated by frequent power supply outages.

Areas affected in Trelawny include: Bounty Hall, Johnson Hill, New Town, sections of Hammersmith, sections of Green Park and higher sections of Schawfield.

At the same time, due to the interconnectivity of the systems, the Barrett Hall community in St. James is also experiencing disruptions as a result of the frequent power outages.
