**MECHANICAL PROBLEMS DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN FORREST HILL
...LEAK CAUSES NO WATER, LOW WATER PRESSURE IN
NINE MILE AREAS**

The National Water Commission is advising that the **Forrest Hills water supply system located in St. Andrew** is currently out of operation due to mechanical problems at the facility. This downtime in operation has resulted in no water conditions to the following areas: **Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle Forrest Hills, Sterling Castle Heights, East Kirkland Heights and Burnside Valley.**

The Commission is reporting that the necessary corrective works are currently in progress and every attempt is being made to restore normal operations at the facility at the earliest possible time.

In the meantime, customers in the **Windsor Lodge, Tone Tone, Claymont Road, Weise Road, Bobo Hill, Taylor Land areas in Nine Miles, St. Andrew**, are experiencing low water pressure or no water conditions due to a broken main on the water supply system.

The repairs to the broken main will be carried out today, and water supply should be restored by 6:00pm this evening.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused by these disruptions in service and is making every effort to restore water supply to all the affected areas at the earliest possible time.
