MAJOR PIPE BREAK DISRUPTS CONSTANT SPRING WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise the public that some customers in Kingston and St. Andrew served by the Constant Spring Water Treatment Plant will be without their normal piped water supply tomorrow (Saturday, June 18, 2011) as a result of a major break and emergency repairs on a 24-inch pipeline.

According to the National Water Commission, the required repairs to the major break on the pipeline cannot be effected without a disruption in water supply for between 12 and 24 hours, starting at about 8:00.

The areas to be affected by no water or low water pressure conditions include Manor Park, Constant Spring, Havendale, Half Way Tree, Constant Spring Gardens, Smokeyvale, Eastwood Park Gardens as well as communities along Constant Spring Road, Red Hills Road, and Mannings Hill Road.

The National Water Commission apologises for the inconvenience and urges customers to store water for use during the period of disruption.
