WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS CONTINUE IN STONY HILL

As works progress under the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP), customers in the **Stony Hill of St. Andrew areas** are being advised that they will continue to experience water supply disruptions and lane restrictions for the week **June 20 to June 24, 2011.**

Areas that will be impacted include:

Hepher Road on Tuesday, June 21, 2011

Tommy Hills and Castle Drive on Wednesday, June 22, 2011

Main Stony Hill Road on Thursday, June 23, 2011

Seaview Road on Friday, June 24, 2011

Where lane restrictions are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Water supply interruptions should also be expected between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm daily.

The company is also reporting that excavation works will be conducted on Panton Road at the junction of Old Stony Hill Road starting on Monday, June 20 through to Saturday, July 9, 2011.

Customers in the mentioned areas are urged to store water for the periods of service disruption and commuters are encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of the flag personnel on location.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary improvement works.
