SCHEDULE FOR STONY HILL JWSIP WORKS

As the National Water Commission continues the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) works in the Stony Hill, St. Andrew, customers in the area are being reminded that they will experience disruptions in their water supply as well as lane restrictions. Areas that will be affected for the week **Monday, June 27 to Friday, July 1, 2011** include:

Sherbourne Heights, Tuesday 28, 2011

Old Stony Hill Road, Wednesday 29, 2011

Panton Road, Thursday June 30 to Friday, July 1, 2011

Mannings Hill Road and Old Golden Spring Road, Friday, July 1, 2011

Customers will experience water supply interruptions between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm daily while lane restrictions, where necessary, will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period. Excavation works will continue on Panton Road as previously reported.

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary improvement works and urges customers in the mentioned areas to store water for use during the periods of disruption while commuter are being encouraged to obey the instructions of the flag personnel on location.
