WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS CORPORATE AREA CUSTOMERS

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **Coorville Gardens, sections of Washington Boulevard and all roads leading off, sections of Washington Gardens and sections of Duhaney Park**, that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to a second broken pipeline along the Washington Boulevard.

The Commission is reporting that repairs to the 9-inch main was completed late last night, however, there is another 16-inch pipeline in close proximity to the first (on the compound of Hardware and Lumber, Spanish Town Road) that is also broken.

The NWC is currently carrying out repair work on the 16-inch main and regular water supply is expected later today.
