WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION....Sections of St. Andrew Affected

The National Water Commission is advising that the **Brentwood Water Supply System** in **St. Andrew** is currently out of operation due to emergency works being carried out on the system. This has resulted in a disruption in water supply to the following areas:

Brentwood, Sterling Castle, Sterling Castle Heights, East Kirkland Heights, Kirkland, Burnside Valley, Red Hills Square, Top Belvedere, Pine View, Pleasant Valley and Belvedere.

The National Water Commission is reporting that this disruption in supply will last until about 10:00pm tonight.

In the meantime, customers in **Rock Pond, Leas Flat, Mosquito Valley, Forrest Hills, Perkins Boulevard, Meadow Brook Estate and Red Hills** who are served by the **Forest Hill Deep Well** are also being advised that the interruption they are experiencing in their water supply is due to power supply problems at the facility. Every effort is being made to restore normalcy to operations at the earliest possible time.
