Mechanical Problems Affect Some NWC Systems

The National Water Commission is reporting that **the Isaac Hole and King Weston** water supply systems in **St. Andrew** are currently out of operation due to extensive mechanical problems at these facilities. This has resulted in no water conditions to the customers in the following areas:

Bucky Plain, Belmont, Grant Hill, Florence Hill, Lawrence Tavern, Mount Ogle, Matthew Road, Toms River, Cokely, Johnny Ridge, Claypole, Burnt Shop, Unity, Top and Bottom Track.

The Commission is advising that the restoration of the systems will take some time and that in the interim, trucked water will be provided to customers in the affected communities.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience that may be caused and will endeavour to restore these systems at the earliest possible time. In the meantime, customers can call the NWC toll free at 1 888 CALL NWC (1-888-225-5692) for further updates and assistance.
