Water Supply Disruptions Affect Sections of Clarendon

The National Water Commission is advising that there is a broken 6” pipeline on the Woodside water supply system in **Clarendon** which has resulted in no water conditions to the following areas: **Denbigh, Glenmuir, Glenmuir Housing Scheme and Foga Road.**

The Commission is reporting that the necessary repair works are currently in progress and every effort is being made to restore water supply by 5:00pm today.

In the meantime, customers in the following Clarendon communities will experience a disruption in their water supply **tomorrow, July 14, 2011 between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm: York Town, Howells Content, Bullards, Content, Hopewell, Parnassus, Denbigh Drive, Foga Road, sections of Four Paths, sections of Rhymesbury and Settlement.**

This interruption in service is to facilitate mechanical repairs to the York Town water supply system.
