JWSIP WORKS CONTINUE IN STONY HILL AREA, ST. ANDREW

As the National Water Commission continues the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) works in Stony Hill, St. Andrew, customers in the area are being reminded that they will experience disruptions in their water supply as well as lane/road restrictions. Areas that will be affected for the week **Monday, July 18 to Friday, July 22, 2011** include:

Seaview Road & Brooks Level Road, Monday, July 18, 2011

Brooks Level Road and Stony Hill Main Road, Tuesday, July 19, 2011

Brooks Level Road & Seaview Road, Wednesday, July 20, 2011 through to Friday, July 22, 2011.

Customers in these vicinities will therefore experience water supply interruptions between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm daily while lane/road restrictions, where necessary, will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period.

The National Water Commission also wishes to advise customers in **Armour Glades and Armour Heights** that they will experience intermittent disruptions in their water supply due to tests being carried out on the distribution network.

Similarly, customers served by the **Seaview Filter Plant** in St. Andrew are also being advised that the facility will be taken out of operation from **8:00am on Wednesday, July 20 until 6:00pm Tuesday, July 21, 2011**, in order to carry out works related to the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP). This will result in no water conditions to the following areas: **Stony Hill, Golden Spring, Jacks Hill, Stilwell Road, Lawrence Tavern, Tavistock, Mannings Hill, Bridgemount, Sunset Avenue, Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle**

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary improvement works and urges customers in the mentioned areas to store water for use during the periods of disruption while commuters are being encouraged to obey the instructions of the flag personnel on location.
