**UPGRADING WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY  
IN STONY HILL**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers served by the **Seaview Water Treatment Plant** in Stony Hill, St. Andrew that the facility will be taken out of operation for a 34-hour period from **8:00am on Wednesday, July 20 until 6:00pm on Thursday, July 21, 2011**. This disruption in service is to facilitate upgrading work on the Ginger River pipeline, the water treatment plant as well as on the Stony Hill distribution system, and is related to improvement works being carried out under the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP).

As a result of these works, the following areas will be without water during the period:

**Golden Spring**

**Jacks Hill, Stilwell Road**

**Lawrence Tavern**

**Tavistock**

**Mannings Hill**

**Bridgemount**

**Sunset Avenue**
