### **WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION FOR SOME ST. CATHERINE AREAS**

The NWC is advising customers in **some areas of St. Catherine** that the low water pressure or no water conditions that they are currently experiencing is as a result of high levels of impurities in the Rio Cobre River. The **Spanish Town Treatment Plant**, has therefore been shutdown, and water is being supplied to the affected communities via wells in the area, namely, Friendship and Brown's Wells. Our water quality engineers are currently assessing the situation.

Areas affected include:

**Spanish Town, Westmore Gardens, Hampton Green, Lakemore Gardens, Newton Avenue, Nugent Street, McCoy's Land, Mayfair Mews, Brunswick Avenue, Job's Lane, White Water Meadows, Hartlands, McCooks Pen, Leiba Gardens, Sydenham Gardens, Wedge Wood Gardens, Willowdene, Hopedale H/S, St. John's Road, Brunswick Avenue, Old Harbour Road, Horizon Park, Homstead, Featherbed Lane**

Restoration of regular service is anticipated for **Thursday, August 4, 2011** when the water quality level is expected to return to normal. In the interim, water will be trucked to some of the affected communities.
