**WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION
Sections of St. Catherine & St. Andrew Affected**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise customers in **sections of St. Andrew** who are served by the **Forrest Hill water supply system** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their service is due to a major leak on the system. The facility has been closed temporarily to carry out the necessary repairs.

Areas affected by this disruption in service include:

Red Hills, Belvedere, East Kirkland Heights, sections of West Kirkland Heights, Plantation Heights, Byron Road, Sterling Castle, Brentwood, Burnside Valley, Mosquito Valley, Rock Pond, Leas Flat and surrounding areas.

In the meantime, customers in **St. Catherine** who are supplied by the **Sunnyside Well** are experiencing a similar interruption in their water supply due to turbidity at the facility. Areas impacted include: **Sunnyside, New Works, sections of Rose Mount District, Rose Hall, sections of Commodore, Wallens Housing Scheme, and sections of Time and Patience.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets the inconvenience caused to its customers in these instances and is making every effort to restore normal water supply to all the affected areas at the earliest possible time.
