Power Supply Problems Affect St. Mary & Portland Systems

The National Water Commission is reporting that the **Grants Level** and **Windsor Forest** water supply systems in **Portland** and the **Gayle Spring pumping station** in St. Mary are currently out of operation due to challenges with power supply.

These downtimes have been reported to the Jamaica Public Service Company Limited and every effort is being made to restore normal power supply at the earliest possible time.

Areas affected in Portland are:

Port Antonio, Grants Level, Passley Garden, Snow Hill, Dragon Bay, Berridale, Fellowship, Stanton, New Road, Boundbrook, Norwich, Tan Hope, Prospect District, Drapers, Windsor Forrest, Commodore, Hartford, Section of Black Rock, Section Of Black Rock, Sections of Long Bay and Fair Prospect.

In the meantime, areas affected in St. Mary include:

Richards Pen, Gayle, Coombs Town, Hyatt Hill, Governor's Pen and Labyrinth Road.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers and is working to ensure the timely restoration of service to all the affected areas.
