**Scheduled Water Supply Disruption
Sections of St. Andrew & Clarendon to be affected**

As the National Water Commission continues the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)** works in **Stony Hill, St. Andrew**, customers in the area are being reminded that they will experience disruptions in their water supply as well as lane restrictions. Areas that will be affected for the week **Monday, August 22 to Friday, August 26, 2011** include:

Brooks Level Road - Monday, August 22, 2011

Heart Academy Road – Tuesday, August 23, 2011

Hillstone Heights – Wednesday, August 24, 2011

Sherbourne Heights – Thursday, August 25 through to Friday, August 26, 2011

Customers will experience water supply interruptions between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm daily while lane restrictions, where necessary, will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period.

In the meantime, customers in **sections of Clarendon** who are served by the **York Town Well** will experience intermittent disruptions in their water supply for the period **Monday, August 22 to Wednesday, August 31, 2011**. These intermittent disruptions will facilitate pipeline replacement works that will be carried out on the distribution network in York Town.

Areas that will be impacted include: **York Town, Howells Content, Bullards Content, Hopewell, Parnassus, Denbigh Drive, Foga Road and Four Paths Settlement.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that these necessary improvement works may cause to its valued customers.
