WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW

National Water Commission customers in **Brooks Level and Boone Hall in the Stony Hill area of St. Andrew** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to emergency works being carried out on a section of the distribution system that serves their community.

The works are in progress and every effort is being made to restore normal water supply to these areas by 5:00pm today.

In the meantime, customers along sections of **Spanish Town Road and Marcus Garvey Drive** in the corporate area will experience a brief interruption in their service **tomorrow, Saturday, August 27, 2011 between the hours of 8:30am and 12:30pm**. This disruption in service is to facilitate pipeline works in these vicinities.
