Bogue Hill Pumping Station out of Operations

The National Water Commission is advising customers in **Bogue Hill, Bogue Heights, Ramble Hill and Bowen Hill** in Montego Bay St. James that the no water conditions that they are currently experiencing is as a result of a mechanical failure at the Bogue Hill pumping station in Montego Bay.

The maintenance team will be extracting the pump today, (Friday, September 9, 2011) for an investigation into the cause of the failure, after which we will be able to advise of a definitive time when the system will return to normalcy.

In the meantime, the NWC will begin to truck water to the affected customers as the needs arise. Timely communication will also be disseminated to provide an update on the situation.

The NWC apologizes for any inconvenience this disruption may have caused and assures customers that no effort is being spared to restore the system back to normality at the shortest possible time.
