NWC WARNS OF CORPORATE AREA WATER
DISRUPTIONS THIS WEEK
Urges Customers to Store Water

The National Water Commission (NWC) is reminding customers in the Corporate Area served by the Constant Spring Water Treatment Plant to expect disruptions in their normal water supply on Tuesday, September 13 (tomorrow) and on Thursday, September 15, 2011 between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm.

These planned temporary closures are to facilitate critical improvement works that will be carried out as part of the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) that aims at delivering an additional 20 million gallons of water each day to meet the water needs in the Corporate Area.

Areas that will be affected include:

Constant Spring Road, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, sections of Havendale, sections of Half-Way-Tree Road, Lady Musgrave Road, Manor Park, Shortwood, Graham Heights, Aylsham, Allerdyce, Acadia, White Hall Gardens, Belgrade, Kingswood, Riva Ridge, Eastwood Park Gardens, Camperdown, Mannings Hill Road, Red Hills Road, Arlene Gardens, Roehampton, Smokey Vale, Lower Jacks Hill Road, Chancery Hall Heights, Jacks Hill, Tavistock, Trench Town, Essex Hall and Calabar Mews.

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary improvement works and urges customers in the affected areas to store water for use during the periods of disruption.
