Water Supply Disruption to Affect Sections of St. Catherine & the Corporate Area

National Water Commission in sections of **St. Catherine and the corporate area are being advised that they will experience a disruption in their water supply on Thursday, September 29, 2011 between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm.** This interruption in service is to facilitate repair works that will be carried out on the Tulloch Springs system in St. Catherine.

Areas in St. Catherine that will be impacted include: Hellshire, West Port, Gregory Park, West Bay, Christian Gardens, Bridgeport, Meadowvale, Hamilton Gardens, Cedar Grove Estate, Passage Fort, Cedar Manor, Marine Park, Watson Grove, Westchester, Independence City, Portsmouth, Cumberland, Mount Royal, Edgewater, Naggo Head, Southboro, Bridgeview, Newland Road, Waterford, Braeton, Kent Village, Eltham Park and surrounding areas.

Sections of the corporate area that will be affected include: Spanish Town Road and all roads leading off, Molyne Road and all roads leading off, Washington Boulevard and all roads leading off and sections of Downtown Kingston.

Customers in all the mentioned areas are being urged to store water for the period of disruption.

The National Water Commission apologizes for any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works.
