**Mechanical Problems Affect Water Supply in Sections St. Mary
...Water Supply Disruption in St. Thomas**

The National Water Commission is advising its customers in **sections of St. Mary who are served by the White River and Agualta Vale water supply systems** that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to mechanical problems associated with these systems.

The company is reporting that the necessary repair works are in progress and that every effort is being to restore normal water supply at the earliest possible time.

Areas affected by this interruption in service include: **Highgate, Richmond, Esher, Lewis Store, Frazerwood, parts of Tremolesworth, Clonmel, Alleppo, Cromwelland, Stockholm Park Housing Scheme, Graham Heights, Harmony Hall, Belfield, Comsee, Orange River Housing Scheme, Capture Land, Bellfield, Clermont Pen, Bellfield Line, Bellfield Pen, Upper Esher, Endeavour, Cascade, St. Mary Country Club, Charles Town, Tree Hills, Rock Cottage and Industry Pen.**

In the meantime, the **Albion Estate and East Albion Wells in St. Thomas** are also out of operation at this time due to power supply and mechanical related problems respectively. Customers served by these facilities are being assured that every effort is being made to resume normal operations and restore water supply at the soonest possible time.

Areas affected by these downtimes in operations include: **Albion, Easington, Yallahs Housing Scheme, Yallahs Industries, Poorman's Corner, Red Hills, Albion Housing Estate, Sun Valley and Grants Pen.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers in these instances.
