**PROJECT WORKS TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN STONY HILL, ST. ANDREW**

The National Water Commission is reporting that customers in the Stony Hill area of St. Andrew will continue to experience instances of water supply disruptions and traffic disturbances as works progress under the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP). For the period, October 3 – 7, 2011, areas that will be impacted as follows:

**Atalion Drive and Golden Spring Main Road – Monday, October 3, 2011**

**Clarks Hill and Golden Spring Road – Tuesday, October 4, 2011**

**Mandela Drive and Golden Spring Road – Wednesday, October 5, 2011 & Thursday, October 6, 2011.**

**Golden Spring Road – Friday, October 7, 2011.**

Customers in these areas should expect water supply interruptions between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm daily and where lane restrictions are necessary, these will occur from 8:00am to 6:00pm for the stated period

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by these necessary works and urges customers to store water for the periods of disruption. Where there are lane restrictions, commuters are also encouraged to observe the signage and instructions of flag personnel who are in place.
