**Mechanical Problems Affect Water Supply  
...Sections of St. Mary & St. Catherine Affected**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that the **Lime Tree Well in St. Catherine** is currently out of operation due to mechanical problems, which has resulted in a disruption in water supply to the **Lime Tree Grove Housing Scheme**.

In an attempt to minimize the extent of the disruption, trucked water will be provided to this area until the restoration of the system.

In the meantime, customers in **sections of St. Mary** who are served by the **Industry Pen and Labyrinth Pumping Stations** are being advised that these systems are still out of operation as previously reported. Works are still in progress to restore operations at these facilities by **Friday, October 14, 2011**.

Trucked water will continue to be provided to the affected areas which include: **Industry Pen Housing Scheme, Tree Hills District, Labyrinth, Goshen, Rose Street, New Pen and sections of Cascade**.

The National Water Commission apologizes to its valued customers for any inconvenience caused by these downtimes and will endeavor to restore regular water supply at the soonest possible time.
