**BLOCKED INTAKE AND BROKEN MAIN AFFECT
WATER SUPPLY
ST. THOMAS AND ST. ANDREW**

National Water Commission customers in some **sections of St. Thomas** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their regular water supply is due to blockages and turbidity affecting some of its systems.

The NWC is reporting that work crews are working to have these intakes cleared in order to restore regular water supply by in the shortest possible time.

Areas affected by this interruption of service include:

Cedar Valley, Crab River, Port Morant, Arntully, Goat Ridge, Needham Pen, Bath, Ward River, Llandeway, Windsor Castle, Somerset, Davis Mountain, Easington and Yallahs.

In the meantime, customers in Cooreville, along Marcus Garvey Drive and Spanish Town Road are also without water as a result of a broken 21-inch main as well as works being carried out on the Rio Cobre Pipeline. Every effort is being made to have repairs effected **by Saturday October 29.**

The NWC sincerely regrets any inconvenience caused to its valued customers.
