SCHEDULED FOR STONY HILL JWSIP WORKS

As the National Water Commission continues the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) works in Stony Hill, St. Andrew**, customers in the area are being reminded that they will experience disruptions in their water supply as well as lane restrictions. Areas that will be affected for **the week of Monday, October 31 to Friday, November 4, 2011 include:**

Golden Spring Road and Schaltelle Close - Monday, October 31, 2011

Airy Castle Road and Live Terrace – Tuesday, November 1, 2011

Gorwell Area and Old Stony Hill Road – Wednesday, November 2, 2011

Golden Spring Road and Hall Green – Thursday, November 3, 2011

Hall Green Heights – Friday, November 4, 2011

Customers will experience water supply interruptions between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily while lane restrictions, where necessary will occur from 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m for the stated period.

Customers in the mentioned areas are being urged to store water for use during the periods of disruption while commuters are being encouraged to obey the directions of the flag personnel on location.

Meanwhile, customers in **some sections of St. Mary** are presently without their regular water supply as a result of mechanical problems affecting the **Annotto Bay Water Pumping Station.**

Affected areas include: **Annotto Bay , Gibraltar Housing Scheme, Iteboreale Housing Scheme and Cricket River.**
