WATER DISRUPTION AFFECTING SECTIONS OF TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission is advising customers served by the **Dornoch Treatment Plant in Trelawny** that the disruption they are currently experiencing is as a result of an electrical problem at the above-mentioned facility.

Areas affected include: **Brompton, Samuel Prospect, Middle Most, Rio Bueno, Calabar and Hatfield Housing scheme.**

The NWC's maintenance team has already started the necessary corrective work, and it is expected that the system will be back into operation by **Monday, November 7, 2011**. In the interim, water will be trucked to the affected customers.
