**MECHANICAL PROBLEM DISRUPTS
ST. THOMAS AND ST. MARY WATER SUPPLY**

NWC customers in **some areas of St. Thomas and St. Mary** are currently experiencing disruptions in their regular water supply. This is as a result of **mechanical problems** affecting **the Apple Farm and Agualta Vale Pumping Stations** respectively.

Areas affected in **St. Thomas** include:

Springfield, Barking Lodge, New Pera, Hill Top, Chapel Hill, Cracket Hill, Ginger Piece, Pear Tree River, Batchelor's Hall, Apple Farm, Dalvey, Duckenfield, Hampton Court, Cheswick, Brownman Hill, Braeton Hill, Hill Sixty, Rocky Point, Winchester, Stokes Hall, Golden Grove and Bowden.

Areas affected in **St. Mary** include:

Highgate, Richmond, Esher, Lewis Store, Frazerwood, parts of Tremolesworth, Clonmel, Alleppo, Cromwelland, Stockholm Park Housing Scheme, Graham Heights, Harmony Hall, Belfield, Comsee, Orange River Housing Scheme, Capture Land, Bellfield, Clermont Pen, Bellfield Line, Bellfield Pen, Upper Esher

Repairs are presently being carried out on both systems and restoration of regular service to all the affected areas is expected **by Friday, November 11, 2011.**
