### **SCHEDULED 3-DAY DISRUPTION FOR STONY HILL ... JWSIP WORKS**

As works progress under the **Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP)**, the National Water Commission is advising customers in the **Stony Hill areas of St. Andrew** that the **Seaview Filter Plant will be shut down for the period Tuesday, November 15 through to Thursday, November 17, 2011.** This necessary shutdown is to facilitate extensive works to the plant and the supply network as works advance steadily under the project.

Customers in the following areas will experience no water conditions for the period that the plant will be out of operation:

**Stony Hill**  
**Golden Spring and all roads leading off**  
**Jacks Hill**  
**Stilwell Road**  
**Lawrence Tavern**  
**Tavistock**  
**Sections of Mannings Hill**  
**Bridgemount**  
**Sunset Avenue**  
**Boone Hall and Mt. Ogle**  
**Temple Hall**

The NWC is reporting that operations will resume at the facility on Thursday evening and that customers should have full restoration of service on Friday, November 18, 2011.

The company is also reminding customers in the areas served by the system that operations will resume on the usual regulated basis and as such the areas that are not normally served on Fridays will not see the return of their water supply until their scheduled service days. These areas include all roads leading off Golden Spring Road.

In the meantime, customers in **Airy Castle Road** and **Live Terrace in Stony Hill** will experience no water conditions on **Monday, November 14, 2011 between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm** due to valve replacement works that will take place in these vicinities.

Whereas trucked water will be provided to the affected areas in order to minimize the extent of the disruption during the closure of the Plant, customers are also being urged to store water for use as far as is possible.

The National Water Commission regrets any inconvenience caused by these necessary improvement works and will provide further updates on **Wednesday, November 16, 2011.**
