WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTS SECTIONS OF ST. CATHERINE

The National Water Commission is advising its customers in **sections of St. Catherine** who are served by the **Ewarton Relift Station** that the low water pressure and no water conditions they are currently experiencing is due to operational challenges associated with the supply system.

The company is reporting that every effort is being made to restore normal water supply at the earliest possible time.

Sections of Church Road

Sections of Bogwalk
