### **WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION**

National Water Commission customers in **sections of St. Catherine** who are served by the **Ewarton Pumping Station** and the **Nutshell Storage Tank** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to operational problems with the supply and distribution networks associated with these systems.

Every effort is being made to restore normal water supply by Wednesday, November 16, 2011. In the meantime, water will be trucked to the affected areas as follows:

- Monday, November 14, 2011 - Ewarton, Charlton, Waterloo, Lluidas Vale Main Road and Leslie Road
- Tuesday, November 15, 2011 - Orange Field Village
- Wednesday, November 16, 2011 - White House, Cotton Piece, Victoria, Banbury and Bynloss

The Commission is reporting that if normality is not restored within the scheduled time, water will continue to be trucked based on the schedule and further updates provided on the matter by Wednesday, November 16, 2011.

In addition, customers in **Aenon Town, Clarendon** will be without their usual water supply for the period **Tuesday, November 15 through to Friday, November 18, 2011**. This is due to extensive repair works that will be carried out on the pumping station that serves the area. Every effort will be made to provide trucked water to the area until regular service is restored.

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused to its customers in these instances.
