### **MECHANICAL PROBLEMS DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY**

National Water Commission customers who are served by the **Barnett Wood Pumping Station in St. Andrew** are presently without their regular water supply as a result of mechanical problems affecting the facility.

The affected areas include:

**Coopers Hill, Castle James, Padmore, Swain Spring, Maverly Mountain, Burnt Side, Burnt Side Valley and the Top sections of Sterling Castle.**

Restoration of regular service is expected on **Monday, November 21, 2011.**

Meanwhile customers in **several St. Catherine and St. Mary communities** are experiencing a similar disruption in service due to mechanical problems at the **White River Intake.**

Areas impacted in **St. Mary** include:

**Jeffrey Town, Windsor, Springfield, Hartland and Decoy**

Areas impacted in **St. Catherine** include:

**Race Course, Jeffrey Town, Decoy, Ragsville, Moreland, Redwood, Middlesex, Guys Hill, Windsor Castle, Barnett and Benbow.**

Restoration of regular water supply is scheduled for **Saturday, November 19, 2011.** In the interim, water will be trucked to the affected areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused by these disruptions in service.
