**URGENT LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT WATER
SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that it will be carrying out urgent repairs to a broken 10 inch pipe in Cue, Hanover on Monday, November 21, 2011, between the hours of 09:00 a.m. and 02:00 p.m.

As a result, some customers served by the Cue Pumping Station will be without piped water while others will experience low water pressure.

The areas that will be impacted include: **Mount Piece, Cue, Clifton, Askenish, Bailey Hill, Chambers Pen, Dias, Cacoon, Water Cress, Richmond, Blenheim, Williamsfield, Middlesex and Greenland.**

The NWC urges customers to store water for use during the scheduled downtime and apologizes for any inconvenience this necessary repair work may cause.
