**WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS FOR
ST. ANDREW AND ST. MARY**

NWC customers who are served by the **Forest Hills Pumping Station in St. Andrew** are being advised that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is due to urgent repair works being carried out at the station.

Areas affected by this disruption include:

Rock Pond, Red Hills, Brentwood, Leas Flat, Belvedere, Mosquito Valley, Sterling Castle and Forest Hills.

The NWC is advising that works are in progress and every effort is being made to restore water supply to the affected areas by **Wednesday, November 23, 2011.**

Meanwhile customers in **Rose Street, Halifax, Elgin Town, Church Village and sections of Lucky Hill in St. Mary** are experiencing a disruption in service as a result of electrical failure at the **Rose Street Relift Station.**

The system is currently out of operation to facilitate corrective works by the Technical Operation Team and efforts are being made to resume regular operations at the earliest possible time.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused by these disruptions in service and will provide further updates to its customers in these regards.
