Project Works to Cause Low Water Pressure/No Water

The National Water Commission is advising that pipeline connection works will be carried out on the **Rio Cobre network on Thursday, November 24, 2011 starting at 8:00 a.m.** These works are being undertaken as part of the Jamaica Water Supply Improvement Project (JWSIP) and may temporarily result in low water pressure or no water supply to some customers in the following **St. Catherine and corporate area communities.**

Kent Village, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens, Christian Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Hellshire, Eltham Acres, Eltham, Greendale, Keystone, St Jago Gardens, Patten Park, Richard Hall, Waterloo Gardens, Ensom Acres, Spanish Town Road and all roads leading off, Molynes Road and all roads leading off, Washington Boulevard and all roads leading off and Sections of Downtown Kingston

Restoration of regular water supply is expected at **8:00p.m on Thursday, November 24, 2011.**

The National Water Commission sincerely regrets any inconvenience that may be caused by this necessary improvement work and encourages customers to store water for use during the period of disruption. The Commission is also assuring that every effort will be made to restore water supply within the specified time.
