**EMERGENCY WORKS DISRUPT
UPPER ST. ANDREW WATER SUPPLY**

The **NWC** is advising customers in **Jacks Hill and surrounding areas** that the disruption they are currently experiencing is due to a **dislocated distribution pipeline**.

Areas affected include:

Upper Jacks Hill, Harriman Close, Skyline Drive, Mountain Spring, Tavistock Heights, Tavistock Terrace and Sunset Avenue.

Repairs are presently being carried out and restoration of regular supply is expected by **10:00 p.m. today**.

Meanwhile, customers served by the **Constant Spring Treatment Plant** are without regular water supply as a result of emergency work being carried out at the facility.

Areas impacted include:

Constant Spring, Norbrook, Cherry Gardens, Havendale, Half Way Tree, Lady Musgrave, Liguanea, Manor Park, Shortwood, Graham Heights, Aylsham, Allerdyce, Acadia, White Hall Gardens, Belgrade, Kingswood, Riva Ridge, Eastwood Park. Gardens, Hughenden and Stillwell Road.

Restoration of regular water supply is expected by **6:00 this evening**.
