**EMERGENCY WORKS DISRUPT
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW**

In follow up to a news release issued on **Wednesday, November 29, 2011**, the **National Water Commission** is advising customers in **Jacks Hill and surrounding areas** that works are still continuing on the **dislocated 9-inch distribution pipeline**.

Affected areas include:

Upper Jacks Hill, Harriman Close, Skyline Drive, Mountain Spring, Tavistock Heights, Tavistock Terrace and Sunset Avenue.

Given the nature and extent of the required repair work, it is expected that regular water supply will be restored by **Sunday, December 4, 2011**.

Meanwhile, customers served by the **Dumfries Water Treatment Plant in St. Thomas** are without regular water supply as a result of a defective pump at the facility.

Areas affected include:

Dumfries, Highbury Crescent, Highbury Road, Pembroke Close and Belfast.

Repairs are currently being effected and regular water supply will be restored as soon as the works are completed.

The NWC regrets the inconvenience caused and will issue updates on the situation.
