**SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. ANDREW**

The **National Water Commission** is advising customers served by the **Mona Filter Plant, in St. Andrew**, that the plant will be shutdown on **Monday, December 5, 2011 from 1:00 p.m to 5:00 p.m.** This will be to facilitate scheduled maintenance work.

Customers in the following areas will be without water during the scheduled maintenance period:

Mona, Cross Roads, Mountain View, Old Hope Road, Devon Square, Waterloo Road, Cassia Park, Eastwood Park, Red Hills Road, lower sections of Grants Pen, Half-Way-Tree Road, Upper sections of Maxfield Avenue, Ziadie Gardens, Dunrobin Avenue, New Kingston, Liguanea, Mona Road, Ravina, Hagley Park Road, Harbour View, Shooters Hill and Bull Bay.

Meanwhile the NWC is also advising customers served by the **Hope Filter Plant in St. Andrew**, that they will experience a similar disruption on **Tuesday, December 6, 2011 between 1:00 pm and 5:00 p.m.** due to scheduled maintenance work that will be carried out at the plant.

Areas that will be without regular water supply include:

August Town, Hope Flats, Papine, Gordon Town, Mona Heights, Hope Road, Beverly Hills, Hope Pastures, Liguanea and Ravina.

Customers in all the affected areas are being urged to store water for use during the period of disruption.
