WATER SUPPLY DISRUPTION AFFECTING SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES & TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers in Irwindale, Irwin Heights, Chelsea, Timber Close and sections of Sign in St. James, that the disruption they are currently experiencing is as a result of emergency maintenance work at the Irwindale facility.

At the same time, customers in Jackson Town, Stewart Town and Diddiford in Trelawny are without water due to a mechanical problem at the Barnstaple Well.

The NWC apologises for any inconvenience this break in service may cause and assures its valued customers that every effort is being made to restore the water supply at the earliest possible time.

In the interim, water will be trucked to the affected areas in St. James and Trelawny.
